I English

Phonics

- J – as in jug
- V – as in van
- W – as in web
- X – as in box

- the names of the 26 letters of the alphabet
- the shapes of the 26 letters of the alphabet (upper and lower case)
- the 31 basic sounds (a to z, and ck, ff, ll, ss, & zz)
- the keywords for the basic sounds

Suggested home activities

- Look at book titles, magazine titles, labels, advertisements, posters, etc. to see the different ways they are written. You might want to get your child to copy some of the styles of printing and writing.
- Let your child write his/her name in as many different ways as possible. Use a variety of coloured writing tools. Your child may wish to decorate his/her name.
- You may also choose to draw the outline of letters to form your child's name. This should be big so that your child can decorate or colour the letters.
- Connections to literacy can occur outdoors at the playground or at the shopping centre. You can point out signs and labels, and draw your child's attention to the letters and beginning sounds that they have covered.

Curriculum

II Chinese

The emphasis in our Chinese programme is that children learn to listen to and understand simple phrases, speak it confidently, and recognise simple Chinese characters. To foster a love for the Chinese language, do continue to give your child opportunities to listen to songs, rhymes and stories.

This term, the following topics will be covered:

- Shapes
- Transportation

亲子活动：关于“形状”，家长可以在日用的饮食中和孩子讨论，例如：饼干、面包的形状，糖果、水果的形状，太阳、月亮的形状等等，引导幼儿结合实际来了解不同的形状。

- 这是什么？

亲子活动：这个单元是有关交通工具，请家长在生活中与幼儿讨论，有关他们自己的玩具交通工具的名称，或者相关故事书等。

Curriculum

III Mathematics

Topics

- Colour, shape and size concepts
- Properties of objects – similarities and differences
- Concept of one, few, and many

Suggested home activities

- Based on the story of *Goldilocks and the Three Bears*, make porridge with your child. Use language such as ‘more’ or ‘less’ when measuring the ingredients. Talk about how you can add more cold water/milk at the end to cool the porridge.
- Provide pictures of different animals for the children to order by size.
- Have a teddy bears’ picnic. Pretend that teddy is at a picnic with you and your child. Ask questions such as, “Who has the biggest apple?” or “Who has the most drink left?”
- Allow your child to help with the weekly grocery shopping and involve him/her using ‘size’ language e.g. ask him/her to point to the biggest box of cornflakes, etc.

Every Friday is Fruit Day

We would like all children to bring some fruit to supplement the meal time on Fridays. The fruit should be pre-cut (if necessary) and easy to consume.



Daily Temperature-taking

- Take child's temperature BEFORE child arrives in school.
- Paste sticker (or masking tape) indicating child's temperature on uniform.
- Children with a fever ($\geq 37.5^{\circ}\text{C}$) are to be kept away from school.
- Children who are sick should not board the bus or arrive in school only for us to discover that they are unwell and have to be sent home. By that time, they may already have infected other children.
- If your child is unwell (fever, cough, sore throat, runny nose, vomiting, diarrhoea and other infectious diseases), please keep him/her away from school.
